

What is PACT? (Partners and Communities Together)

PACT gives residents of Wolverhampton an opportunity to regularly meet with their local police staff and Local Neighbourhood Partnership team with the aim to tackle crime locally. The scheme provides local people with a practical way to influence what happens in their neighbourhood by working with the police and council to determine local policing priorities. At your local meeting you can:

- Meet representatives from the police and council
- Help identify local Anti Social Behaviour and crime concerns
- Be informed on performance of local policing
- Receive feedback on previous priorities
- Seek help on individual or community wide problems

PACT forms part of the new policing pledge which sets out standards the public can expect from the police. For more information on the West Midlands Policing pledge please go to:

How can I get involved?

Meetings are taking place across the city and dates are available below. Why not your local meetings and help prioritise local issues that will make your area a better place to live and work in? In addition to formal meetings in some months you may find different methods will be used to talk with local people which may include street briefings, surgeries, stalls at supermarkets, promotional police vehicles and other locally determined engagement tools.

Who should come to these meetings?

- Active volunteers who can help shape local priorities
- Neighbourhood Watch Co-ordinators
- Anyone with a concern around crime in the area
- People who would like to get more involved in local crime fighting
- Representatives from community groups who can be a single voice for a number of local people
